

What Parents & Students Say About TY*

- 81% of students rate their TY experience as very good or excellent.
- 37% of students rate work experience, 24% rate exposure to new subjects & 21% rate the wide variety of experiences as the three best aspects of TY
- 78% of students state that exposure to new subjects helped either a great deal or a lot when choosing optional LC subjects
- 77% of students state that TY Work Experience helped them to make decisions about potential future careers &/or courses
- 72% of students state that they would 'strongly encourage' other students to do TY based on their experience
 - 82% of parents/guardians state that the TY fee is excellent value for money
 - 77% of parents/guardians feel that their son is more mature after TY
- 63% of parents/guardians feel that their son is more able to work independently after TY
 - 68% of parents/guardians feel that their son possesses better skills after TY
 - 72% of parents/guardians feel that their son is more self confident after doing TY
 - 68% of parents/guardians feel that their son is better organised after TY
- 74% of parents/guardians feel that their son is better able to communicate after TY.
 - NCCA Study (2006):

TY Students gain 46 more CAO points in their LC than students who don't do TY.

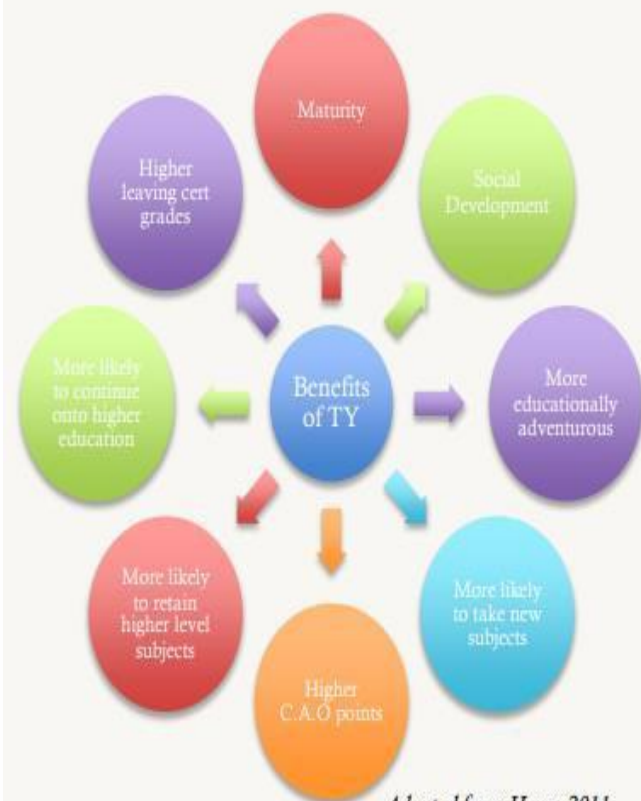
